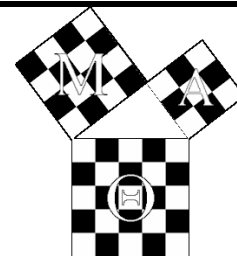


Mathematical Minutes Video Contest

The Mu Alpha Theta Mathematical Minutes Video Contest wants members to create educational and entertaining videos. Get together with a few friends from your math club, pick a math topic, and create an informative video.

Mathematical Enthusiasts,

The following are the rules for the Video Contest:

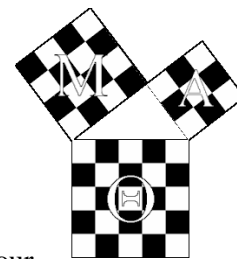
1. Videos should not exceed 5 minutes in length.
2. Videos should teach a lesson in an interesting or innovative way.
3. Topics should be accessible to high school students with an interest in math.
4. Audio must be understandable.
5. Images must be clear and relevant to the topic.
6. Math should be correct.
7. Videos will be judged on the originality of their presentation.
8. All copyrights must be respected. Any use of video, imagery, or music must meet copyright and fair-use laws. Any entries that do not meet this standard will not be considered eligible.
9. The decisions of the judges are FINAL.
10. Eight videos will be chosen for the final round of judging. Up to \$2,250.00 will be available to be split amongst the entries by quality. Chapters will be involved in the voting for the ranking the top 8 videos. Final award amounts will be determined by these votes, along with input from the Governing Council.
11. Deadline is January 31st, 2013 by midnight E.S.T.
12. The first round of judging will be completed by February 28th.
13. The San Diego National Convention plans to award INTERSCHOOL points for any qualified videos submitted.
14. Videos should not include any references to the school or its name. Instructions for identifying your school are included in the YouTube instructions.

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Mu Alpha Theta Video Competition Guidelines



1. **Topic** – Pick a topic that would be of interest to high school math students. Tell us about your favorite math trick, tip or topic.
2. **Length** – There is no hard and fast rule for the length of a successful video although you should adhere to the 5-minute maximum. Tell your story. The video HAS to be educational AND entertaining. Remember: If WE snooze, YOU lose!
3. **Format** – Final submissions are to be uploaded to YouTube. The video links have to be sent to the email listed below.
4. **Deadline** - All videos must be submitted **January 31st, 2013**. Results will be posted at a later date.
